

# GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Graduation will be authorized by the GDPA Board of Education, and a diploma will be granted to all students who have met the following requirements:

1. Earn a minimum of 26 credits
2. Complete the specific course requirements for graduation
3. Pass all GDPA School Exams

#### GDPA Policy on Repeating a Course

Unless otherwise stated in the course description, a **high school course** that was completed (i.e., you received a grade of A, B, C, D, or F,) may be repeated once.

**Exception:** You may retake courses required for graduation as many times as needed until a passing grade is earned.

**Important:** Credit toward your high school diploma is given for only one course, and it will be noted on the transcript that the course was repeated. The higher of the two grades will be counted toward your cumulative GPA. Always check with your academic advisor before re-registering

A student must complete all high school graduation requirements (required courses, credits,) by the end of the spring semester of the senior year to be eligible to participate in the commencement ceremony.

## PROMOTION AND RETENTION

**Grade level:** 9th - 12th

**Requirement:** The student must earn a minimum of 5 credits per year to move to the next class standing.

### Criteria:

Students must achieve a minimum score of 60 to be awarded credit for the course. Any student that does not meet the criteria must repeat the course again.
