Thank you for inquiring about our High School Basketball Program. We are very excited to potentially have you, or your child join the #WarriorFamily! We are honored that you are considering our program and what we have to offer. Our High School Programs are built on the premise of EDUCATION 1ST! All of our core courses have been approved by the NCAA and are accepted in colleges and universities. We understand that without education, basketball is just basketball. But education and basketball together create an opportunity for our studentathletes to earn a free college education, and that is our ultimate goal! To be a part of our basketball program, students must maintain a 2.3 core gpa. (The only exception are students transferring in.) High School students are required to take (and pass) Math, Science, Social Studies and English courses each year. 2 years of a foreign language are also required. A typical day at GDPA for our athletes consists of core courses from 8:30am-12:45pm, followed by lunch. After lunch our student-athletes enter their Athletic PEP (Personalized Education Plan) which will consist of skill development, film study, weightlifting, ACT/SAT Prep Courses, life skills management courses etc. We believe that to become a collegiate athlete, preparation is required. Therefore, the elective courses that normal students take have been replaced by courses that will prepare our students for the next level.

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Tuition Breakdown Cont.

The total tuition for the year is \$15,000 which can be broken up into payments. There is a **nonrefundable** \$500 roster reservation fee due when they application is returned. The initial payment of \$3000 is due on or before August 1, 2024. After that payment there will be eight (8) \$1437.50 monthly payments due on the 1st of each month. There will be a 3-day grace period before late payment penalties will be added. After 3 days, a 5% (\$72) fee will be added to the monthly fee. After 5 days, **another** 10% (\$215) fee will be added. After 10 days, the student will be removed from the academy.

Financial Aid

The government gives financial assistance to parents that desire for their children to attend private school. A \$6000 grant is available for those that qualify and while funds are available.
