Enroll in community college (online and part time), take SAT/ACT Prep Courses, or enroll in our PlusOne Program. We are also active in the community, volunteering to help our senior citizens and mentoring the youth in the community are also required. Our desire is to not only prepare our athletes for the next level but to give them a head start. We have a very rigorous daily schedule (see below). We work extremely hard! Tuition Breakdown Cont.

The total tuition for the year is \$15,000 which can be broken up into payments. There is a **nonrefundable** \$500 roster reservation fee due when they application is returned. The initial payment of \$3000 is due on or before September 1, 2024. After that payment there will be five (5) \$2400 monthly payments due on the 1st of October, November, December, January, and February. There will be a 3-day grace period before late payment penalties will be added. After 3 days, a 5% (\$120) fee will be added to the monthly fee. After 5 days, **another** 10% (\$240) fee will be added. After 10 days, the player will be asked to leave the program.

Financial Aid

We require each player to enroll in college for two reasons. 1st, to give them a head-start on college courses for the next year. And 2nd, to lower the out-of-pocket costs for parents. If a player is eligible for financial aid through Fasfa, when they enroll in college as a part time student, they are normally granted about \$6000 in Pell grant money each year. That would instantly lower the out-of-pocket tuition cost to \$9000. If you (your child) still need financial help, they would also be eligible for student loans that could take care of the remaining balance. As we stated, the ultimate goal is for our athletes to earn a free college education, so hopefully this would be the only student loan needed for college. In some rare cases, our program may be able to offer financial aid if help is still needed.
